In California, some children begin transitional kindergarten at age 4, kindergarten at age 5 or at age 6. The DRDP is calibrated to accommodate a broader range of abilities. There is some overlap both with the DRDP-Infant/Toddler instrument and the DRDP-K instrument in order to encompass the range of abilities.
