Every living human being is a temple, a dwelling place, of God since s/he has a body but not every person is a church, the Bride of Christ. A body becomes a church when the Holy Spirit dwells in the body. Since God is spirit and Jesus is God, and God is a trinity, the human body in which the Holy Spirit dwells becomes the Body of Christ.

What is a Church and What is a Temple

What is key here is: (1) the body of Christ becomes a holy temple in the Lord Jesus Christ, and (2) we become God’s dwelling place by the Holy Spirit. In short, human persons become the body of Jesus Christ—we the body and Christ the head (or cornerstone). The Spirit indwells us in ways similar to how the Spirit indwells Christ.
